GENERAL WORKERS (20)

Zambezi River Authority is seeking twenty (20) highly motivated, suitably qualified, and experienced Zambian/Zimbabwean Nationals to carry out general work on seasonal basis in the Projects and Dam Management Services Department, to be based at Kariba Office, Zimbabwe for a period of three (3) months.

JOB PURPOSE

To remove and haul overgrowth from the South and North Banks, including the general cleaning of storm drains, dam galleries and shafts, chipping and removing calcite from dam gallery centre drains and audits and shafts, spraying of bats, rodents and pests from galleries, audits, and shafts and surface re-sealing of the South Bank by stone pitching and shotcrete.

Under the supervision of the Artisan Dam Maintenance, the General Workers will carry out the following key responsibilities: -

- 1 Removal and hauling of overgrowth from the South and North Banks.
- 2 Chipping and removal of calcite from dam gallery centre drains and in adits and shafts.
- 3 Spraying of bats, rodents and pests from galleries, adits and shafts
- 4 Surface re-sealing of the South Bank by stone pitching and shotcrete.
